## Guidelines for Documenting PsychologicaDisabilities

The Disability Services Office at Hamlinumiversity arranges reasonable accommodations for students with diagnosed psychological disabilities. Psychological bisorder, provide but are not limited to: Depressive Disorders, Postaumatic Stress Disorder, Bipolar Disorder Disorder Disorders. To determine eligibility for accommodations and services, this office requires current and comprehensive documentation of the disability from the diagnosing psychiatrist, psychologist, or other qualified licensed professional. Disability documentation and related information will be kept in a confidential file in the Disability Services office.

The following guidelines are provided in the interest of assuring that the evaluation and report are appropriate for eligibility and identifying reasonable accommodations. Documentation must show the current impact of the disability. The age of acceptable documentation dependent upon the stability of the disorder and the current functioning of the student.

The documentation must:

- 1. Be prepared by an appropriately trained and credentialed health care professional (psychiatrist, psychologist, neupsychologist or other licensed mental health or medical professional);
- 2. Sta
